THE NOVATO **PLANNING COMMISSION** WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING:

PROJECT NAME & APPLICATION NO.:	Costco Fuel Facility (gas station) P2020-025
PROJECT LOCATION:	300 Vintage Way, adjacent to the existing Costco store APN 153-340-36
<b>PROJECT DESCRIPTION:</b> Costco Wholesale has proposed to construct and operate a gas station adjacent to its existing store located in the Vintage Oaks Shopping Center. The project includes the construction of an approximately 10,000 square-foot canopy that will cover 14 fuel dispensers that accommodate 28 fueling positions. Additional improvements include three 40,000-gallon gasoline underground storage tanks (UST), one 1,500-gallon additive UST, a controller enclosure, vapor processor unit, and associated site improvements. Project entitlements require approval of a use permit and design review. The Planning Commission will consider certification (approval) of the Final EIR and approval of the project entitlements at this hearing.
