Project Location: Coyote Creek along Cardinal Road, east of Flamingo Road, Tamalpais Valley, Marin County, CA

Project Description: The Project aims to address chronic seepage issues associated with Coyote Creek and tidal water coming from Richardson Bay by constructing a new steel sheet pile floodwall with a height extending 3 feet above the existing floodwall along an approximately 1,100-foot segment of the Cardinal Road levee. The project also includes installing a new storm drain system, removing concrete drain boxes, and replacing a culvert.

The Flood Control and Water Conservation District Board approved the project on April 7, 2026, and has made the following determinations:

1. The project in its approved form will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of the approval of the project.
4. Findings were made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
