

1. **Project Name:** Homestead/Mill Valley Paving Project
2. **Project Location:** Unincorporated Marin County
3. **Project Description:** This project generally includes resurfacing the following roads: California Avenue from Julia Avenue to end, Centro Way from Greenhill Road to West California, Helen Avenue from Almonte Blvd to Morning Sun Avenue, North Vernal Avenue from Vernal Avenue to Vernal Way, Vernal Avenue from Greenhill Road to North Vernal Avenue, Yale Avenue from Morning Sun Avenue to California Avenue, Harvard Ave from California Avenue to California Avenue, Vernal Way from Vernal Avenue to end, Brookline Avenue from Northern Avenue to Midvale Way, West Fairview Avenue from Midvale Way to end, Wellesley Avenue from Median Way to end, Princeton Avenue from Harvard Avenue to end, Holly Street from Montford Avenue to end, Montford Avenue from Laverne Avenue to Melrose Avenue, Amaranth Blvd from Sequoia Valley Road to end, Hawk Hill Road from Princeton Ave to West end, Live Oak Drive from Marin Avenue to end, Pineo Avenue from Maple Avenue to end, Poplar Street from Highway 1 to Marin Avenue, Smith Road from Marin Drive to Marin Drive, Sunset Way from Highway 1 to Woodside Avenue, Chamberlain Court from Highway 1 to End, Everest Court from Chamberlain Court to End, Springside Way from Pine Hill Road to Woodside Avenue. Improvements include asphalt grinding, pavement digouts, asphalt overlay, full depth asphalt repair, minor concrete work such as curb and gutter, minor storm drain improvements, traffic striping, and other related work.
