

MCCOA Summary Report from Cities and Towns

JURISDICTION: City of Mill Valley

LWMV and the Mill Valley Library is talking with Dan Steckline to do a presentation about assisted living and long-term care options in August.

We are also putting a team together to create a “Fall Fair” – literally a Don’t Fall Fair that would feature tips on fall prevention, ways to make a home safer, tai chi lessons, etc. The Southern Marin Fire District would collaborate at this event.

One of the members of the LWMV Steering committee is on the Mill Valley Traffic and Mobility Advisory Committee. Discussions about ways to improve transportation, accessibility and safety for the community, especially older adults and disabled people are ongoing.

The group is also looking into the importance of make aging-related programming feel welcoming, social, and fun rather than overly clinical or focused only on “senior” services.

The group talked about ways to reduce social isolation and improve communication and outreach.
