The Civic Center Green Stormwater Infrastructure Project is a multi-phase project to build green stormwater infrastructure to treat many of the campus parking lots. The current project being advertised is Phase1 which includes construction of two bioretention systems adjacent to the Civic Center “panhandle” parking lot located south of the Marin County Corporation Yard (4 Peter Behr Dr. San Rafael, CA 94903).

There is a mandatory pre-bid conference scheduled for this project on **July 1, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.** at the Civic Center Campus, 3501 Civic Center Dr. Bidders shall meet at the “panhandle” parking lot south of the Civic Center Corporation Yard, which is located at 4 Peter Behr Dr. San Rafael, CA 94903.Exact location here: <https://maps.app.goo.gl/4fZ4JgYBCzTizEaPA>

The Engineer’s estimate for this project is \$500,000.

The Working Days for this project are 50 days.

Bidder shall possess a valid Class A and a C27 license at the time of bid submittal.

All bids must include a bid security for at least ten percent (10%) of the base bid, in the form of cash, certified or cashier’s check, or bidder’s bond.

This is a public works contract subject to the provisions of Labor Code Sec. 1720 et seq. Contractor and all subcontractors shall pay not less than current prevailing wage rates as determined by the Cal. Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) to all workers employed on the project. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by DIR.

A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, or perform work on this project unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code Sec. 1725.5.

Copies of the prevailing wage rates for this project are available from the County and will be made available upon request.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code section 22300, at the request and expense of the contractor to whom the Contract is awarded, securities of a value equivalent to the retention amount, in a form approved by the County, shall be permitted in substitution for money withheld by the County to ensure performance under the Contract.

The County reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any bid irregularity to the extent permitted by law. If the County elects to award a contract, the contract will be to the lowest responsible bidder. All bids shall remain valid for sixty (60) days after the bid opening.
