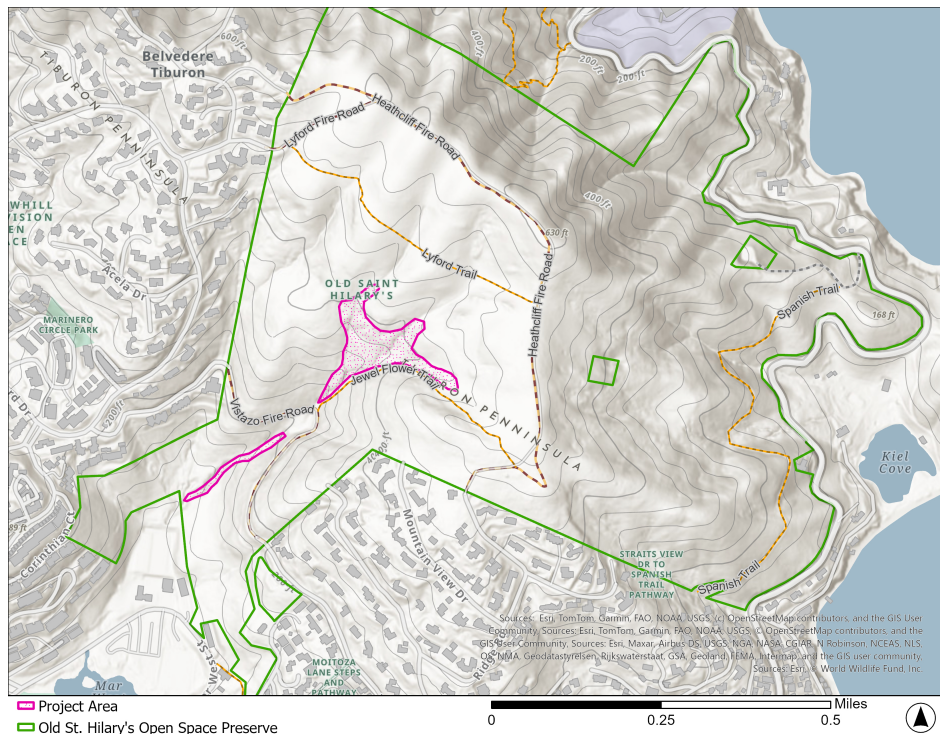

Acacia, firethorn, blackberry, cherry plum, and cotoneaster are fast growing, weedy plants which can spread quickly if left unmanaged.

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Staff will carefully place a small amount of herbicide onto the cut stump of each plant.

Stopping the spread of these invasive species helps to protect rare species like the Tiburon jewel flower, and reduces fire risk.



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
