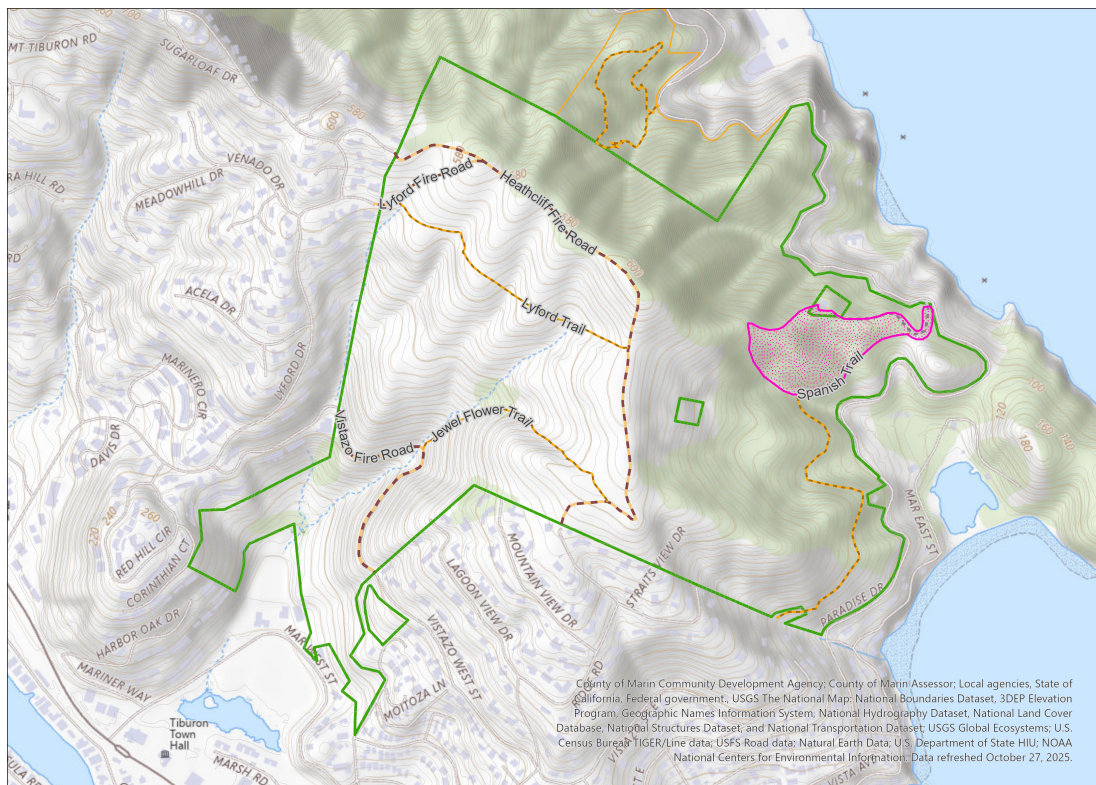

French broom is an invasive shrub that displaces native plants and wildlife, and creates hazardous ladder fuels that contribute to fire danger. Removal of French broom creates safer conditions and helps to conserve biodiversity in our Open Space preserves. French broom will be carefully spot-sprayed using a triclopyr-based herbicide.
