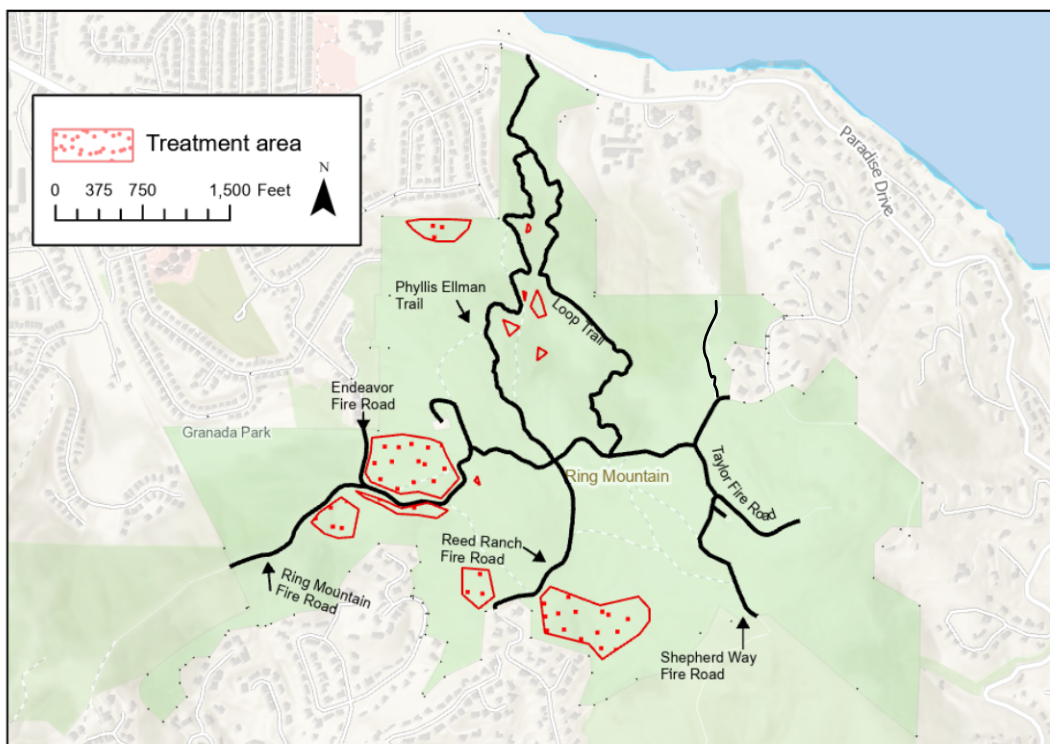

PREVENTING INVASIVE WEEDS

August 25 - 27, 2026



Mayten, cotoneaster, fennel, and eucalyptus are fast-growing invasive plants, which can spread quickly if left unmanaged.

Staff carefully place a small amount of herbicide onto each plant.

Stopping the spread of these invasive species helps to protect rare species like the Tiburon Mariposa lily, and reduces fire risk.

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
